TREASURER'S REPORT

LG arranged a startup grant of £8,000. A refund for electricity use totalled just over £1,000.

Water usage refund was £350.

Total funds are £19, 650.

CHARITY STATUS AND NEW HALL

AR has contacted Land Registry and Community First and will now begin the process of applying to become a CIO.

NC-S will contact Ryedale District Council to confirm if a new hall can be built on the present car park. The sub-committee (HL, AR, WT, NC-S, AC-S) will then meet with Jake Harrison to discuss initial plans.

Dog Show at 3pm.
HL to organise a gin and whiskey prize raffle.
CR to run a produce stall.
Gemma Leggett to run the tombola.
LG to obtain a QR Code if needed.
A group photograph will take place at 4pm.
NC-S will organise printing of a newsletter and schedule for distribution in both villages.
"Wish list cards" will be set out to add ideas to the survey ideas for the new hall.
