received a grant from **North Yorkshire County council** towards the cost of commemorating HM Queen Elizabeth's Platinum Jubilee. We thank all our sponsors.

The Charity has worked with the Village Hall Committee to ensure that most of the funds are utilised for the benefit of all Villagers in celebrating the occasion over the extended June Bank Holiday.

The remainder of the grant has been put towards a tree that has been planted on the village green adjacent to Wildsmith House to commemorate the Jubilee. A permanent plaque is being obtained to replace the temporary one currently in place. The tree, a Prunus Aviam, or flowering wild cherry, was purchased locally, and is a very old variety that originated in Cornwall

around the 17th Century

The Reverend Brian Shackleton will dedicate the tree to commemorate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee on Sunday 5th June at 12.30 p.m. It is hoped that villagers will attend the event opposite the chapel

Join in afterwards by having your own afternoon tea on the green to celebrate in the village, bring your own chairs, food, and drink for this social event of Jubilee celebration for the villagers
