PREVIOUS MINUTES

Minutes from the previous meeting on Tuesday 23rd May 2023 were agreed.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

NC-S thanked those who attended the previous meeting who are not on the Committee.

E-mail sent to Tony Harrison thanking him for the amazing plans. A final bill of £500 has been received from Jake Harrison.

AR and NC-S visited Pat Woodall today 6th June to explain to her that the village Hall Committee would not currently be moving forward with the plans to purchase her land, explaining the reasons why, mainly the ability of the village to raise all the funds required. For the time being this project is to be put to bed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Assets are £15432.92

£400 is owed to the Parish Council.

LN is to set up a standing order to Ryeslay (Pest Control) for £15 per month.

Authorisation for AR to be added as an extra signatory is being organised.

LN has set up a Money Management program to run the accounts on the computer to enable the banking to be reconciled on a monthly basis. Reports can be printed off itemising all entries that have gone through the account.

Paul Styles has offered financial advice help and will audit the accounts annually.

WORK TO BE COMPLETED TO UPDATE THE HALL

NC-S suggested the Committee should think and consider what is required to be done to the Hall to keep it up to date.

Andy Holt could be used to do joinery and odd jobs. New Fire Doors are needed.

AR suggested a 20ft Shipping Container could be used for storage. AT to approach Bulmer's Logistics at Normanby Manor to enquire as to whether they could help us in any way.

After MMJC had approached us to see if they could merge with the Village Hall, at the last meeting it was decided to reject their offer. This was due to the extra workload put on to the Committee. MMJC had e-mailed back to state that they were surprised and disappointed by the decision. NC-S replied to explain why. No further action is required.
